## AN INTRODUCTION TO PLAYWRITING

Theatre Royal Windsor's new playwriting course offers aspiring theatre makers the chance to channel their creativity into something unique. Beginning **Saturday 25<sup>th</sup> September**, this course will consist of weekly two hour sessions aimed at developing writing skills and exploring new ideas.

The course will be led by **Grae Cleugh**, winner of the **2002 Laurence Olivier Award** for "Most Promising Playwright" and described as "a rising star of British Theatre" (*The Times*).

Teaching will be a combination of lectures, analysis and discussion of dramatic texts, in addition to practical exercises. A small amount of research/ homework will be given as preparation for the following week's session.

The course structure will be as follows:

- Week 1 – Introduction
- Week 2 – Ideas/Themes/Titles
- Week 3 – Story/Plot
- Week 4 – Structure and Style
- Week 5 – Characters
- Week 6 – Action
- Week 7 – Dialogue and Subtext
- Week 8 – Writer's Voice
- Week 9 – Endings
- Week 10 – Further Development/Getting Your Play Produced
